The Accounting Standards Board (Board) at their meeting held on the 1 March 2005 approved for release the following Invitations to Comment (ITC):

- ***DP 1 – Discussion Paper on Intangible Assets***
- ***DP 2 – Discussion Paper on Heritage Assets***

These ITCs will obtain views and comments on the issues discussed in the discussion papers to enable the Board to prepare exposure drafts on intangible assets and heritage assets. As these ITCs might present challenges for some preparers, auditors and users of general purpose financial statements the Board is grateful for the time respondents are devoting to consider the views in these ITCs and to comment on it. The responses will form a valuable input in the development of exposure draft on intangible assets and heritage assets. Those who might be affected by, or are interested in the exposure drafts issued by the Board, are encouraged to continue to provide responses to the documents being released.
