"15.03 No [goods brought into the Republic for commercial purposes, whether or not for own use, shall be entered in terms of the provisions of section 38.1 person -

(a) entering the Republic shall remove his or her baggage, or any other goods accompanying him or her, from customs and excise control, or cause such baggage or goods to be so removed unless so authorized by the Controller; and

(b) shall deliver any such baggage or goods left with him or her or handed to him or her for delivery unless release has been granted.
