MARINE LIVING RESOURCES ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1998)

I, Marthinus van Schalkwyk, Minister of Environmental Affairs and Tourism, hereby under section 77 of the Marine Living Resources Act, 1998 (Act No. 18 of 1998) ("the Act"), made the Regulations as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the regulations published under Government Notice No. 1111 of 2 September 1998, **as** amended.

Amendment of Annexure 2 of the Regulations

2. Annexure 2 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for PART A, item 7, of the following item:

"7 West coast rock lobster: the holder of a-

- (a) commercial fishing permit – from 1 June to 15 November in any one year, both dates inclusive; or
- (b) recreational fishing permit – from 3 May to 15 November in any year, both dates inclusive."

3. Annexure 2 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for PART B, item 2 of the following item:

"West coast rock lobster – during the open season, a recreational fishing permit is only valid for fishing as follows: everyday from 16 November to 31 January, and from 1 February to 2 May only on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, provided that all west coast rock lobster caught in terms of a recreational permit must be landed between 08h00 and 16h00."
