AMENDMENT TO THE INVITATION TO APPLY FOR FOUR YEAR COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING LICENCE

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice to amend notice 2466 of Government Gazette No. 26957 published in terms of section 41(1) of the Independent BroadcastingAuthority Act, No 153 of 1993, as amended ("the Act") on 1 November 2004. The abovementioned Government Gazette invited interested parties to apply #or four year community sound broadcasting licences in accordance with Section 78 of the Act as well as sections 32(3) and 32(4) of the Broadcasting Act No 4 of 1999, as amended ("Broadcasting Act") to provide community sound broadcasting services. The closing date for the submission of the applications is hereby amended as set out in the schedule below.
- 2. Pursuant to the Act, ICASA hereby determines the form and manner of the invitation as follows:
 - 2.1 Subject matter of this invitation: Application for a community sound broadcasting licence.
 - 2.1 Number of licences: Eighteen (18) community sound broadcasting licences.
 - 2.3 Term of the licence: Four (4) years from the date of issue of the licence.
 - 2.4 Applications shall be made by non-profit making juristic persons.
 - Applicants **shall** be responsible for the review and interpretation of the invitation. No **liability shall** accrue to the Authority if, due to the applicant's failure to **comply with** such requirements, the application is rejected or disqualified by the Authority.

- 2.6 Each applicant shall be responsible for the assessment and analysis of the relevant regulatory environment. The Authority and its employees shall not be responsible for any disadvantage suffered by an applicant, prior to, during, or subsequent to the application process as a result of the inaccurate assessment and analysis of the regulatory environment or for any other reason whatsoever.
- 2.7 Applications must be completed substantially in accordance with the Information contained, and the particulars requested, in the prescribed application form as well as the Position Paper on Community Sound Broadcastingobtainable from the Authority.
- 2.0 Application forms and the Position Paper on Four Year Community Sound Broadcasting Services are available at the Authority's Library, 164 Katherine Street, Block D, Pinmill Farm, during office hours. The Position Paper on Four Year Community Sound Broadcasting Services is also available on the Authority's website at www.icasa.org.za.
