NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 50 (4) OF THE NATIONAL FORESTS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1998)

RELEASE OF STATE FOREST LAND AT SEDERBERG, GROOTVADERSBOSCH, HAWEQUAS, (LIMIETBERG) AND KOGELBERG FOREST 'RESERVES - WESTERN CAPE, WHICH IS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR FORESTRY PURPOSES

By virtue of the power vested in me by section 50 (3) of the National Forests Act, 1998, (Act **No. 84 £** 1998). I, Buyelwa Patience Sonjica, in my capacity as Minister of Water Affairs and Forestry hereby release State forests at Sederberg, Grootvadersbosch, Hawequas, Kogelberg Forests reserves-Western Cape, which are no longer required for forestry puposes, **namely-**
