(b) Allocation Process determined by Cluster

For purposes of the long term rights allocation process, the 19 fishing sectors are grouped together in four dusters for the assessment of applications for fishing rights. The purpose of clustering fisheries together is administrative, procedural and, to a lesser extent, substantive. However, different criteria and weighting may be applied to sectors falling within the same cluster. The clusters are:
