#### DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

## CONSUMER AFFAIRS (UNFAIR BUSINESS PRACTICES) ACT, 1988

In terms of the provisions of section 8(4) of the Consumer Affairs (Unfair Business Practices) Act, 1988 (Act No 71 of 1988), notice is hereby given that the Consumer Affairs Committee intends undertaking an investigation in terms of section 8(1)(b) of the said Act into the advertisement in news papers, magazines, other print media, and electronic media offering "workfrom home opportunities".

These "work from home opportunities" include, but are not confined to:

- 1, typing work and/or
- 2. addressing (typing & writing) envelopes of any kind whatsoever and/or
- 3. addressing (typing or writing) labels of any kind whatsoever and/or
- 4. the filling of envelops of any kind whatsoever and/or
- 5. administrative opportunities and/or
- the gathering of names and addresses and/or
- 7. compiling of data
- 8. the direct sellers of consumer goods who do *not* truthfully identify themselves, the firm and their products in any advertisements

### "Work from home opportunities" excludes:

- 1. typing work requested by the purchaser of such service, such as the typing of assignments required by learners and students.
- 2. the direct selling of consumer goods in which a sales person:

- (a) either demonstrates the product or presents a product catalogue in homes, the workplace or similar places away from **shops**
- (b) collects an order
- (c)subsequently delivers the goods personally or arranges delivery
- (d) collects payments for goods or arranges for payment or **credit** transactions
- (e) applies "person to person" selling, "party plan" selling, "multilevel marketing" and "network marketing",

provided that the direct sellers truthfully identify themselves, the firm and their products in advertisements.

3. Mai - orders entities such as manufacturers, wholesalers or retailers who contact buyers through direct mail, catalogs, television, radio, magazines, and newspapers and deliver the goods ordered by them to a post office or a physical address nominated by clients.
