APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A FOUR YEAR BROADCASTING LICENCE CONDITIONS NEW PAN-HELLENIC VOICE

1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice, in terms of the provisions of section **44(2)** of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, No **153** of **1993**, as amended, that it has received an application from New Pan-Hellenic Voice for the renewal of its community sound broadcasting licence in terms of section **44(1)**. 2. The application is available and open for inspection by interested persons in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.
3. Interested persons are invited to lodge written representations in relation to the application by no later than **29 July 2005**. 4. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof must simultaneously indicate whether they also require an opportunity to make oral representations to the Authority.

Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, shall at the time of lodgement furnish proof to the satisfaction of the authority that a **copy** of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr Costas Nicolaou, New Pan-Hellenic Voice 7 Civin Drive, Senderwood or sent by registered post to **PO Box 4077** Edenvale **1610** or faxed to **(011) 453 8233**.

6. New Pan- Hellenic Voice shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the proposed renewal, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within sixty (60) days of the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*. New Pan-Hellenic Voice must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
