THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL ROADS AGENCY LIMITED**DECLARATION OF EXISTING PROVINCIAL ROADS – (I) PROVINCIAL ROAD P81 SECTION 5, (II) PROVINCIAL ROAD P78 SECTION 1 AS NATIONAL ROAD N2 – DISTRICTS OF ERMELO, WAKKERSTROOM AND PIET RETIEF.**

By virtue of Section 40(1)(a) of the South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998), I hereby declare **(I)** the Section **of** Provincial Road P81 Section 5, also known as N2, commencing from Ermelo **up** to Piet Retief, and **(II)** the Section of Provincial Road P78 Section 1, also known as N2, continuing from Piet Retief **up** to the intersection with the Mpumalanga/KwaZulu Natal Provincial Border, as described in the Annexure hereto, to be a National Road.

ANNEXURE**(i) Description of existing proclaimed Provincial Road P81 5 between Ermelo and Piet Retief.**

The Section of Route N2, also known as Provincial Road P81-5 and R29, as previously declared by Administrator Notices as Provincial Road, commencing from the Western abutment of the Rail Bridge No. B 2493 at Ermelo, there from on proceeding in a general South-Easterly direction on existing Provincial Road P81-5 up to junction with Theo Mocke Street, North of Piet Retief, where it terminates.

[Ermelo – Piet Retief]

(ii) Description of existing Provincial Road P78-1-between Piet Retief and the Mpumalanga/KwaZulu Natal Provincial Border.

The Section of Route N2, also known as Provincial Road P78-1 and R29, as previously declared by Administrator Notices as Provincial Road, again commencing from a point in line with the Southern boundary of the Erf 349 of Piet Retief Town and Townlands 149 – HT, South of Piet Retief, there from on proceeding in a general South-Easterly direction on existing Provincial Road P78-1 up to a point where it joins the existing National Road N2, as declared by National Road Declaration No. 1352 of 22 September 2003, on the Western boundary of the farm Belgrade 27 – KU, being the Mpumalanga/KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Border, where it terminates.

[Piet Retief – Mpumalanga/KwaZulu Natal Provincial Border]

(National Road N2: Ermelo to Mpumalanga/KwaZulu Natal Provincial Border)
