### 6. Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment, Ownership and Control

It is proposed that the Regulation 6.3 be inserted under Regulation 6 as follows:

6.3 The Authority in accordance with the objectives of this Act and the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act must consider:

- (a) when granting a licence the empowerment of historically disadvantaged groups including women and the youth and people with disabilities;
- (b) the promotion of broad-based black economic empowerment; and
- (c) as far as is reasonably possible the application of any relevant code of good practice issued in terms of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act when determining qualification criteria for the issuance of licences
