Lepelle (change of name from Olifants River)	A river in Bohlabela District in Limpopo
Luvuvhu (correction of spelling from Levubu)	A river in Vhembe District in Limpopo
Malan	A village 10 km N of Wellington in the Western Cape
Malan Stasie	A railway station 10 km N of Wellington in the Western Cape
Modatzwi	A river in Mopani District in Limpopo
Mogwadi (change of name from Houtsriver)	A river and a dam in Capricon in Limpopo
Molototzi	A river in Mopani District in Limpopo
Monnamme	A river in Mopani District in Limpopo
Mononono (change of name from Dwars River)	A river in Polokwane in Limpopo
Mooketzi (change of name from Koedoes)	A river in Mopani District in Limpopo
Mosukudutzi (change of name from Brandboontjies)	A river in Mopani District in Limpopo

Motlatse (change of name from **Blyde** A river in Bohlabela district in Limpopo River)

Mulaudzi (change of name from **Blood** A river in Capricon in Limpopo River)

Polokwane (change of name from **Sand** A river in CApricon in Limpopo River)
