APPLICATION FOR A LOW POWER COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING LICENCE: NORTH-WEST UNIVERSITY (RADIO PUK)

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (the Authority) hereby gives notice in terms of section 41 of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, 153 of the 1993 that it has received in terms of section 5(2)(e) of the Broadcasting Act, 4 of 1999, as amended, read with the guidelines to apply for a low power sound broadcasting licences as per Notice No. 296 of 2005 in Government Gazette No. 27308 dated 18 February 2005, an application for a low power community sound broadcasting service. The details of the application are contained in the schedule below.
- 2. The application is available and open for inspection **by** interested persons in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.

- 4. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof must simultaneously indicate whether they also require an opportunity to make oral representations to the Authority.
