### NOTICE 1258 OF 2005

#### DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1941 (ACT 17 OF 1941)

#### PROPOSED PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF CERTAIN WORDS AND EMBLEMS FOR FIFA WORLD CUP 2006

I, Mandisi Mphahlela, Minister of Trade and Industry, in **pursuance of the** requirements of Section 13 of the **Merchandise** Marks Act 1941 (Act 17 of 1941), hereby give notice that the Federation Internationale de **Football Association** (FIFA), **has** conveyed a request for a prohibition, in terms of **Section 15(1)(b)** of the said Act, on the use of certain **words** and emblems as depicted in **the attached document (Annexure A)** in connection with **any** trade, business, profession, occupation or event, or in connection with a trade mark, mark **or** trade description applied to goods **other** than the **use** thereof by FIFA **or** its mandatories.

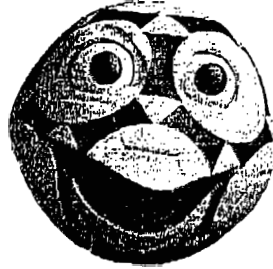
