BOARD NOTICE

NOTICE 121 OF 2005

The South African Council for the Project and Construction Management Professions

Rules relating to the Payment of Fees for Registered Persons with the Council for the Project and Construction Management Professions Act, 2000 (Act No. 48 of 2000)

1. This notice is effective as from 01 January 2006.
2. Annual fees - persons registered with the Council in terms of the Act, 48 of 2000, shall be required to pay a pro rata amount of the applicable annual fee calculated from the first day of the month following the month of registration until the end of the financial year on the 31 March annually.
3. Appeal fees - the amount shall be refunded should the appeal be successful.
4. Penalty for late annual (re-)registration fee – failure to pay the annual fee within 60 days from it becoming due, or within such further period as the Council may allow, either before or after the expiry of the 60 days, as per section 20 (1) of the Act, 48 of 2000; will be liable to bear a penalty interest calculated at 2% per month for the total number of months in default.
5. A registered person remains liable for any fees, arrears or penalty imposed by the Council for the period that he or she was registered in terms of section 20(4) of the Act, 48 of 2000.
6. The Council may in terms of section 20(1) cancel the registration of the registered person if he or she fails to pay the prescribed fee.
7. The fees prescribed are inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT).
