INDEPENDENT COMMISSION FOR THE REMUNERATION OF PUBLIC OFFICE BEARERS

- 1. In terms of Section 219 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 and Section 8(4) of the Independent Commission for the Remuneration of Public Office-1997, the Commission shall publish annually in the Gazette Bearers Act. recommendations regarding the salary, allowances and benefits of any member of the Cabinet, Deputy Minister, any member of the National Assembly, any permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces, any member of any national or provincial house of traditional leaders or any traditional leader. The Commission is also obliged lo publish in the Gazette recommendations regarding the upper limits of the salary, allowances and benefits of any member of the Executive Council of a province, any member of any provincial legislature or any member of any Municipal Council of any category or type of municipality as well as the resources which are necessary to enable an office-bearer to perform the office-bearef's function. In addition thereto the Commission is also obliged to publish in the Gazette recommendations regarding the salaries, benefits and allowances payable to Constitutional Court Judges, Judges and Magistrates.
- 2. Interested person/organizations/institutions are hereby invited to submit proposals in writing on the remuneration of the public office-bearers referred to in paragraph 1 above. Proposals should focus on salaries. allowances and other benefits.
- 3.
