INVESTIGATION INTO THE FUEL SHORTAGES EXPERIENCED DURING DECEMBER 2005

- · Refining capacity and state of repair;
- Refinery shut-down planning;
- · Wholesaler-retailer relationships;
- Communication channels;
- Handling of phase-in period towards upgraded specifications (2010 specifications)
- Obligations of Basic Fuel Price (BFP) on holding finished products; and
- Compensation of consumers during this fuel crisis
