**DECLARATION OF EXISTING PROVINCIAL ROAD - PROVINCIAL TRUNK ROAD 1 ■
SECTIONS 1 TO 7, AS NATIONAL ROAD N7 SECTIONS 1 TO 6 - DISTRICTS OF
MALMESBURY, MOORREESBURG, PIKETBERG, CLANWILLIAM AND VANRHYNSDORP.
[FROM MR199 (MELKBOSSTRAND) TO WESTERN CAPE/NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCIAL
BORDER]**

By virtue of section 40(1)(a) of the South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998), I hereby declare Provincial Trunk Road TR11 Sections 1 to 7, also known as Route N7, all as declared by Administrator Notice no. 267 of 1971 and all other notices which might be relevant to this section of road, commencing from its junction with Main Road MR199 on the farm Baas Ariesfontein Outspan 77 (Km 18.02), from where it proceeds in a general northerly direction along the existing Provincial Trunk Road TR11 Sections 1 to 7 through the township of Malmesbury from road reserve to road reserve, bypassing the townships of Moorreesburg, Piketberg, Citrusdal, Clanwilliam, Vanrhynsdorp, Nuwerus and Bitterfontein up to the Western Cape/Northern Cape Provincial Border, also the common boundary between the farms Bruintjies Hoogte 40 and Meul where it terminates, to be a National Road.
