

**NOTICE IN TERMS OF THE PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY REGULATION ACT,
2001(ACT No.56 OF 2001): EXEMPTION IN TERMS OF
SECTION 20(5) OF THE ACT**

I, Charles Nqakula, Minister for Safety and Security, have, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 20(5) of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No. 56 of 2001) after consultation with the Council for the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority, exempted the management of Beaufort-Wes Plaaswagklub, from the Private Security Industry Regulations Act, 2001, on condition that -

- the Farm Watch co-ordinator must register in terms of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No. 56 of 2001)
- the Farm Watch co-ordinator must remain in the employ of Beaufort-Wes Plaaswagklub
- the constitution of Beaufort-Wes Plaaswagklub, as provided during the application for exemption, must not be amended
- the exemption will only be valid for a period of five years from the date hereof.
