**APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND
OBJECTIONS THERETO**

SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 76 OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)

The under mentioned bodies and persons have applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of their heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

1. **APPLICANT:** Endurance Ride Association of South Africa (H4/3/1/4062)

BADGE: (HONORARY COLOURS: **SENIORS**) On a background Vert, a leaping springbok proper, above his back, to sinister, two horseshoes in fess, within each a faceted four pointed star, all **Or**.

2. **APPLICANT:** Endurance Ride Association of South Africa (H4/3/1/4063)

BADGE: (HONORARY COLOURS: **JUNIORS**) On a background Azure, a leaping springbok proper, above his back, to sinister, two horseshoes in fess, within each a faceted four pointed star, all Argent.

3. **APPLICANT:** Hantam Municipality (H4/3/2/773)

ARMS: Per fess Or and Vert, a bar wavy, per fess wavy Azure and Argent, in base a merino ram proper; a chief consisting of two peaks embattled Gules. The shield is ensigned with a rustic mural crown Or, masoned Sable, heightened on the crenellations and crenells with representations of bound wooden palisades Brunatre. The shield is flanked on either side by two red nutgrass flowers leafed proper, issuant from a rocky ground below the lower edge of the shield.

4. **APPLICANT:** Kai !Garib Municipality (H4/3/2/779)

ARMS: Argent, a base Barry wavy Azure and Argent, in chief between a bunch of grapes and a dorper sheep, a quiver tree, proper. The shield is ensigned with a rustic mural crown Or, masoned Sable, heightened on the crenellations and crenells with representations of bound wooden palisades Brunâtre.

MOTTO: SAAMAS EENHEID

5. APPLICANT: Thabazimbi Municipality (H4/3/2/808)

ARMS: Per chevron embowed embattled abaise Or and Vert, in chief dexter a rondavel hut and sinister a leopard's face proper, and in base a cycad tree Or; a chief dancetty Argent, filleted Azure, issuant therefrom a demi-sun Gules; at fess point a chemical symbol for iron, the point surmounting the fillet Azure. The shield is flanked on either side with a cycad branch Vert.

MOTTO: WORKING TOGETHER FOR PROSPERITY

6. APPLICANT: Emakhazeni Local Municipality (H4/3/2/814)

ARMS: Per saltire Or, in the flanks Brunatre and Azure, a saltire Argent, charged on each limb with three lozenges conjoined Sable, between in chief three fir trees conjoined Vert, in each flank four billets fesswise in pale Argent, and in base a trout proper. The shield is ensigned of a rustic mural crown Brunatre, masoned Sable, heightened with four maize cobs, Argent, leafed Or, alternated with as many snowflakes Azure.

MOTTO: KUMNYAMA KOBOMVU SIYANQOBA

7. APPLICANT: Inxuba Yethemba Municipality (H4/3/2/818)

ARMS: Per fess Azure and Vert, on a fess wavy per fess Azure and Or, a chain in fess per fess counterchanged, between in chief three houses issuant and conjoined Argent, and in base, surmounting two pickaxes in saltire with hafts Or and bars Argent, a merino ram's head proper. The shield is ensigned of a zebra skin headring, issuant therefrom a torch Or, enflamed proper.

MOTTO: UNITED TO SERVE

8. APPLICANT: David Gibson Barnfather (H4/3/4/819)

ARMS: Gules, two chevronels Sable, fimbriated Argent, each charged with three mullets of the third, between in chief two swords in saltire proper, hilted Or, and in base a Viking helmet Or, horned Argent.

CREST: A Viking ship proper, the sail Argent, charged with a wild boar's head couped close Or, armed Argent, langued Gules, at the mast head a pennant floutant Gules.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Gules and Or.

MOTTO: MANEO ET TRIUMPHO

9. APPLICANT: Johann Wilhelm Grobler (H4/3/4/830)

ARMS: Argent, a chevron Gules, between in chief dexter a tree aloof and sinister two forestry axes in saltire proper, and in base a heraldic fountain.

CREST: Statant upon a rocky ridge a lammergeyer regardant proper.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Gules and Argent.

MOTTO: GROBLEBEN

10. APPLICANT: Ryan Patrick Alford (H4/3/4/831)

ARMS: Potent counter-potent, Argent and Azure, a griffin segreant Gules, beaked, armed, langued, rayed, and incensed Or.

CREST: Statant within a palisado crown Or, a Moorcock crowing Sable, crested, beaked jelloped and armed Gules, charged with a mullet, within a mascle Or.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Argent.

MOTTO: VINDICEM VINDICANS
