 - 4. state whether it relies or intends to rely on any expert evidence and if so, provide a *brief* summary of that expert evidence; and
 - 5. specify its address, telephone number (if any) and telefax number (if any).
- D. Any interested party requiring an opportunity to make oral representations must-
 - 1. so indicate by writing to the commission on or before the 30th April 2006;
 - 2 state the nature of its interest in the investigation;
 - 3. state whether it relies or intends to rely on any expert evidence, and if so, provide a brief summary of that expert evidence; and
