NOTICE OF INTENT

NATIONAL ROAD 17: SECTIONS 2, 3, 4, & 5: NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DECLARE THAT SECTION OF THE NATIONAL ROAD 17 FROM SPRINGS (GAUTENG PROVINCE) TO THE OSHOEK BORDER POST (MPUMALANGA PROVINCE) AS A **CONTINOUS** TOLL ROAD

In terms of Section 27(4)(a) of The South African National Road Agency Limited and National Roads Act, 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998), The South African National Roads Agency Limited hereby gives notice of its intention to recommend to the Minister of Transport the declaration of the following National Road section as a toll road:

A Portion of existing National Road 17: Section 2, commencing from the common cadastral boundary of Portion 133 and the Remainder of Portion 118 of the farm Daggafontein No: 125- IR from where it commences in an easterly direction along the N17 section 2 up to the Gauteng/ Mpumalanga Border on the comment cadastral boundary of the Remainder of Portion 6 of the farm Winterhoek No: 314-IR and the Remainder of Portion 8 of the farm Rietfontein No: 313-IR, declared a national road in terms of Government Gazette No: 28729 of 13 April 2006,

from where it continues in a easterly direction along the declared National Road 17: Sections 3 & 4 up to a point west of the Town Ermelo on the Remainder of the farm Nooitgedacht No: 268-IT and declared a national road in terms of Government Gazette No: 27143 of 7 January 2005; and

from where it continues from a point east of the Town Ermelo from where the National Road 17: Section 5 commences from Oos Street and commencing in a easterly direction along the National Road 17: Section 5 up to the Oshoek Border Post and declared a national road in terms of Government Gazette No: 28730 of 13 April 2006.

The total length of the proposed toll road is approximately 246km and approximate positions of the toll plazas are depicted on the attached plan.

In terms of Section 27(4)(a)(ii) of the said Act all interested persons are hereby invited to comment and make written representations, within 30 days from the date of notice, to The South African National Roads Agency Limited, on the proposed declaration.
