SCHEDULE

DEFINITION OF PRODUCTION AREA BOT RIVER

That portion of land situate within the following boundaries:

Start at the point where the western boundary of The Draay 563, just east of the township area of Kleinmond, meets the Atlantic Ocean; thence first north and then generally east with !he western and northern boundaries of said The Draay 563 to the north-eastern beacon thereof; thence further east with an imaginary straight line to the south-western beacon of Lekker Water 545; thence further east with the southern boundary of said Lekker Water 545 and the northern boundary of The Draay 563 to the north-eastern beacon thereof; thence northeast with the north-western boundary of Hermanus River 542 to the northem beacon thereof; thence generally north-east with the general western boundaries of farms 474, 781,473, 820 and Compagnies Drift 435 to a point where the N2freeway intersects the western boundary of said Compagnies Drift 435; thence north-east with the north-western boundary of said Compagnies Drift 435 to the northern beacon thereof; thence further north-east with an imaginary straight line, which is an extension of the north-western boundary of Compagnies Drift 435, to the northern beacon of farm 791; thence north-west with an imaginary straight line to the south-western beacon of farm 867; thence north with the western boundaries of said farm 867 and farms 866, Krakeel Poort 274 and Goedvertrouw 264 to the north-western beacon thereof; thence north-east far about 1925 metres with the north-western boundary of said Goedvertrouw 264 to a point where an imaginary straight line, drown from the junction of the secondary roads (south-east of the farm Kanaan) joins it; thence south-east with the secondary road to where it Joins the R43-road; thence south with said R43road to where it joins the N2-freeway; thence south-west with said N2-freeway to a point where it intersects the north-eastern boundary of farm 362; thence generally south with said boundary and the eastern boundary of Avontuur 429 to

where it joins the north-western boundary of Heuwelkraal 843; thence south-west with said north-western boundary of Heuwelkraal 843 and an imaginary straight line, which **is** an extension of said boundary, to where **it joins** the south-eastern beacon of farm 880; thence south-west with the **south-eastern** boundary of **said** farm 880 to a point where the Swart River intersects said boundary; thence **south-east** with **said** Swart River to a point **where** it intersects the western boundary of farm 475; thence south with an imaginary straight line to the northern beacon of Paarde Poort 539; thence west to where it Joins the eastern boundary of Josephs Kraal 540; thence first north and then generally south with the eastern and general western boundaries of said Josephs Kraal 540 to where it joins the north-eastern beacon of Afdaks Rivier 575; thence generally southwest with the general eastern boundaries of said Afdaks Rivier 575 to a point where the R43-road intersects the south-western boundary thereof; thence north with said R43-road to the township Fisherhaven; thence north-west with the eastern boundary of said township to where it joins the Bot River Lagoon; thence generally south-west with the south eastern boundary of said lagoon to the Atlantic Ocean; thence north-west with the coastline to the point where the western boundary of The Draay 563 meets the Atlantic Ocean, the point of beginning mentioned above.
