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PUBLIC NOTICE BY ORGANISING FIELD 07, HUMAN AND SOCIAL STUDIES, TO RE-REGISTER A STANDARDS GENERATING BODY (SGB) FOR VICTIM EMPOWERMENT

The Directorate for Standards Setting and Development hereby re-registers the SGB for Victim Empowerment in the Sub-Field of People/Human-Centred Development from July 2006 until July 2009.

PROPOSED BRIEF OF THE SGB

- 1. Identify transformation, development, access and equity issues relevant to Victim Empowerment and develop mechanisms to include these issues within the standards and qualifications as envisaged in (4) below [Regulation 24 (1)(e)].
- 2. Develop learning and career pathways for potential Unit Standards and Qualifications in Victim Empowerment from NQF levels 2 to 6 [Regulation 24 (1)(e)].
- 3. Generate Qualifications and Unit Standards in Victim Empowerment in accordance with Authority requirements at NQF levels 2 to 4 [Regulation 24 (1)(a)] including:
 - National Certificate: Victim Empowerment and Support (NQF level 2)
 - National Certificate: Victim Empowerment Projects (NQF level 3)
 - FETC: Victim Empowerment Co-ordination (NQF level 4)
 - Unit Standards at NQF Levels 2-6
- 4. Recommend the qualifications and/or standards generated under 3 above to Organising Field 07 [Regulation 24 (1)(c)].
- 5. Liaise with other Standards Generating Bodies (SGBs) in the Sub-Fields whose briefs mandate them to generate Victim Empowerment related Qualifications and Unit Standards [Regulation 24 (1)(a) & (e)].
- **6.** Recommend criteria for the registration of assessors and moderators or moderating bodies *[Regulation 24 (1)(d)]*.
- 7. Review registered Unit Standards that have reached the end of their registration period and make recommendations on their reregistration [Regulation 24 (1)(b)].
- 8. Accept and perform other related functions as requested by Organising Field 07 [Regulation 24 (1)(e)].
