Description:	 The Affordable Comfort Home is a building system comprising: 2400 mm x 1000 mm x 60 mm superstructure wall panels fabricated from two sheets of pre-coated galvanised sheet steel encapsulating an expanded polyurethane core cast in-situ concrete slab-on-the-ground and stiffened raft foundations which in all cases are designed by a professional engineer. galvanised steel ridge beam spans between and is anchored to external eaves walls external walls have an oven-baked polyester coating to both sides and internally are clad with x-rated gypsum plasterboard 15 mm thick vertical joints are tongued-and-groove and wall panels are anchored to a galvanised sheet steel angle which in turn is secured to the foundation slab with expansion bolts internal wall panels are the same as external wall panels, clad both sides with gypsum plasterboard (the same as external wall panels) ceiling panels are the same as wall panels (without gypsum plasterboard cladding) window and door frames are manufactured from polyvinyl chloride-unplasticised(PVC-u) conventional services
