SCHEDULE

DEFINITION OF PRODUCTION AREA HEMEL-EN-AARDE VALLEY

That portion of land situate within the following boundaries:

Start at the point where the main road (320) from Sandbaai to Caledon intersects the southern boundary of Hemel en Aarde 587, south-east of the De Bos Dam; thence west with the southern boundary of said Hemel en Aarde 587 to the south-western beacon thereof; thence north with the western boundary of said Hemel en Aarde 587 to a point where the Karwyderskraal road intersects said boundary, west of the De Bos Dam; thence north-west with said Karwyderskraal road to a point where said road intersects the western boundary of Kawyderskraal 584; thence north with said western boundary to the north-western beacon of said Karwyderskraal 584; thence east with the northern boundaries of said Karwyderskraal 584 and Hemel en Aarde 587 to the north-eastern beacon thereof; thence generally first south and then south-west with the general eastern and southern boundaries of Hemel en Aarde 587 to a point where the main road (320) from Sandbaai to Caledon intersects said southern boundary of Hemel en Aarde 587, the point of beginning mentioned above.
