#### PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL ACT, 1983

#### IMPOSITION OF LEVIES ON PERISHABLE PRODUCTS

#### AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT STANDARDS

In terms of section 17(i) of the Perishable Products Export Control Act, 1983 (Act No. 9 of 1983), and by virtue of the Board's appointment as Assignee in terms of Regulation 1978 of the Agricultural Products Standards Act, 1990 (Act No. 119 of 1990), the Board hereby imposes the following levy and tariff adjustments in respect of each of the products specified below, which may be exported from the Republic of South Africa. These levies will be valid from 1 October 2006 until further notice.

#### INSPECTION LEVIES (AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT STANDARDS)

<u>Products</u>	<u>Inspection Fee</u>
Grapes (less than 5 kilograms)	28.65 cents per container in a consignment
Grapes (more than 5 kilograms)	57.30 cents per container in a consignment
Pome fruit	32.89 cents per container in a consignment
Pome fruit in bulk bins	32.89 cents per 12,5 kilograms or part thereof
Stone fruit	35.86 cents per container in a consignment

- Above levies exclude VAT of 14%.
- In all instances where a service is delivered and unit rates are not sufficient to cover costs, PPECB will retain the right to, at its discretion, charge hour and or kilometre rates instead of or in addition to the published fees above. For administrative purposes hour and kilometre rates may be adapted to an equivalent tariff per unit.

Until further notice, all other levies charged by the Perishable Products Export Control Board including hour and kilometre rates, will remain unchanged as per Board Notice 101 of 2005 published in Government Gazette 28122 of 21 October 2005.
