NATIONAL ROUTE 1: GREAT NORTH TOLL ROAD: MAKHADO - MASEKWASPOORT: BAOBAB MAINLINE TOLL PLAZA: PUBLICATION OF THE SUSPENSION OF TOLL LEVIED AT THE AFOREMENTIONED TOLL PLAZA IN TERMS OF GOVERNMENT GAZETTE NO: 28477 DATED | 0 FEBRUARY 2006, FOR CERTAIN PERIODS, TIMES AND CATEGORIES OF VEHICLES.

The South African National Roads Agency Limited ("SANRAL") hereby, in terms of section 27(1)(e) of The South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act 1998, (Act No: 7 of 1998). makes known that for the periods and times specified below, the levying of toll at the Baobab Mainline Toll Plaza ("Toll Plaza") is suspended to the effect that all vehicles traveling through the Toll Plaza at such times and for the said period, will not be required to pay any toll. Other than for the suspension of tolls at the Toll Plaza for the period and times specified below, tolls will continue to be levied and are payable on the basis and in the manner contemplated in Government Gazette No: 28477 dated 10 February 2006.

The period and times during which the levying of tolls is suspended are as follows:

- 1. Period: from the first applicable day subsequent to the 14" day after publication of this notice in the Government Gazette and until 14 December 2006, or such earlier or later date as may be published by SANRAL in a notice in a subsequent Government Gazette;
- 2. Times: on every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during the period specified above and between the hours of 08:30 and 16:00; and
- 3. Categories: Class 1, 2, 3 and 4

Notwithstanding the suspension of tolls on the basis contemplated above, all vehicles will still be required, during the period and for the times specified above, to stop at the Toll Plaza for auditing purposes.

The reason for the suspension of the levying of toll at the Toll Plaza, for the period and times specified above, is that SANRAL is executing certain geotechnical and road safety improvements on Section 29 of National Route 1 between Makhado and Masekwaspoort, which will require vehicles to be diverted to a detour via the Witvlag Road.
