PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL ACT, 1983

IMPOSITIONOF LEVIES ON PERISHABLE PRODUCTS

In terms of section 17(i) of the Perishable Products Export Control Act, 1983 (Act No.9 of 1983), the Board hereby imposes the following levies, in respect of each of the under mentioned perishable products, as defined in section 1 (i)of the above mentioned Act, which may be exported from the Republic of South Africa. These levies will be valid from 1 April 2007 until further notice.
