PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL BOARD

PERISHABLE PRODUCTS EXPORT CONTROL ACT, 1983

IMPOSITION OF LEVIES ON PERISHABLE PRODUCTS

In terms of section 17(i) of the Perishable Products Export Control Act, 1983 (Act No.9 of 1983), the Board hereby imposes the following levies, in respect of each of the under mentioned perishable products, as defined in section 1 (i) of the above mentioned Act, which may be exported from the Republic of South Africa. These levies will be valid from 1 April 2007 until further notice.

- * Rate will apply to all pallets containerized within a radius of 5 kilometers from one of the three export harbour's in the Republic of South Africa namely Durban, Port Elizabeth and Cape Town.

- All levies by pallet will be based on the standard ISO pallet size.
- All levies by kilogram will be based on gross weight.

- After hour callouts are defined as all callouts made outside Normal Time (8am to 5 pm weekdays) and will be charged for at the Normal Overtime or Sunday & Public holiday hour rate.
