
TRANSFORMATION OF THE LANGEBERG IRRIGATION BOARD, MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT OF ROBERTSON, WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE, INTO THE KABOUS RIVER WATER USER ASSOCIATION, WATER MANAGEMENT AREA NUMBER 18, WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE,

I, Silas Seani Mbedzi. Chief Director: Institutional Oversight of the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry, duly authorised thereto by the Minister of Water Affairs and Forestry, hereby in terms of section 98(6) of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No 36 of 1998), hereby declare that –

- (a) the Langeberg Irrigation Board is a water user association;
- (h) the Association's name is the Kabous River Water User Association;
- (c) the area of operation of the Kabous River Water User Association includes all properties in respect of which any person is entitled to use water (surface and underground water) by virtue of entitlements in terms of section 22(1) of the Act from -
 - (i) The water provisioning system in the Langeberg Mountains above the farm Jan Harmensgat No. 179 that originates in the Leeu River Mountain Reserve. From there in a southern direction till the *farm* Sand Drift No. 220 that borders on the Breede River where the Kabous River flows into the Breede River. It also includes the farms within a north-western direction from the farm Jan Harmensgat No. 179 up to and including the farm Remhoogte. It also includes a greater part of the farm Bosjesmanspad No. 173 as well as portion 10 (portion of portion 3) of the farm Jan Harmensgat No. 179 situated in a north-easterly direction; and
 - (ii) any other water resource(s) and/or waterwork(s) situated outside the area described in paragraph (c)(i) above. which water resource(s) and/or waterwork(s) and accompanying area the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry or the responsible authority may require the Association to control,

which is situated in water management area number 18 in the Western Cape Province; and

- (d) the constitution of the Kabous River Water User Association has been approved.
