

#### DELEGATION OF POWERS IN TERMS OF THE CONTROL OF ACCESS TO PUBLIC PREMISES AND VEHICLES ACT, 1985 (ACT NO. 53 OF 1985)

I, Charles Nqakula, in my capacity as Minister for Safety and Security, acting under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in section 5 of the Control of Access to Public Premises and Vehicles Act, 1985 (Act No. 53 of 1985), —

- (a) hereby delegate the powers listed in the Schedule hereto to the functionary indicated; and
- (b) hereby withdraw —
  - (i) Government Notice No. 1288 of 25 August 1995; and
  - (ii) Government Notice No. 1750 of 5 December 2003.

#### SCHEDULE

	<i>Description of power</i>	<i>Functionary at the lowest post, post level or rank to whom the power is delegated</i>
Section 1	The power to, by notice in the <i>Gazette</i> , declare an object to be a dangerous object for purposes of the Act.	Deputy National Commissioner responsible for Operational Services.
Section 1	The power to, by notice in the <i>Gazette</i> , declare a council, board or body to be a statutory body for purposes of the Act.	Deputy National Commissioner responsible for Operational Services.
Section 2(2)(g)	The power to, by notice in the <i>Gazette</i> , determine premises or a vehicle or a class of premises or vehicles which may be searched by an authorised officer.	Deputy National Commissioner responsible for Operational Services.
