Name of product: "Narn-Tex" White Roofing Undertile Membrane

Certificate holder: Nampak L & CP

Description: The "Nam-Tex" White Roofing Undertile Membrane is manufactured

from two outer layers of non-woven, UV- stabilised, spunbonded polypropylene. The two outer layers of spunbond material are laminated together using a blend of polypropylene, low density polyethylene, and UV stabiliser. The membrane has a weight of 107 g/m² and a thickness of 0, 34 mm. It is supplied in rolls 30 m long

and 1, 5 *in* wide.

"Nam-Tex" White Roofing Undertile Membrane is suitable for installation in all tiled-roof buildings with timber roof construction having a pitch of less than 60 degree. It was not evaluated for metal roof construction and side-wall cladding. It can be used in all regions of South Africa when used in the conventional manner to:

- reduce air movement between tiles, since the membrane can contribute to maintaining a balanced air pressure on both sides of the roof tiles
- reduce ingress to the roof space of wind-driven rain and dust.
