SCHEDULE*Description of work*

1. Hoisting of men, rock and material at the Production and Service Shafts;
2. Loading and tramping of the broken rock;
3. Marking off and drilling of the underground excavations;
4. Charging up and blasting of the underground excavations;
5. Making safe, cleaning and the installation of support in the underground excavations;
6. Charging up and blasting of the oversize rock;
7. Loading, crushing and transportation of ore to the surface stockpiles;
8. Loading, transportation and crushing of ore from the surface stockpiles to the plant; &
9. Loading and transportation of rock to Foskor Limited.

Description of mine

The mine known as Palabora Underground Mining Operations, which is situated on the farms Laaste 24 LU, Sheila 10 KU, Merensky 32 LU, Wegsteek 30 LU, Vereeniging 11 KU and Loole 31 LU, in the Magisterial District of Phalaborwa, Limpopo Province, and at present being worked by Palabora Mining Company Limited, P O Box 177, Phalaborwa, 1390.
