

**BOARD NOTICE 93 OF 2007**  
**HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA**  
**RULES RELATING TO CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR**  
**REGISTERED HEALTH PRACTITIONERS: AMENDMENT**

The Health Professions Council of South Africa has, under section 61(5) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), amended the rules promulgated as Board Notice No. 29 of 2007 and published on 23 March 2007.

**SCHEDULE**

**Definitions**

1. In this Schedule, reference to the “**Rules**” means the rules relating to continuing education and training for registered health practitioners published as Board Notice No. 29 of 2007, and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Rules shall have that meaning.
  
2. **Amendment of Rule 4 of the rules**
  - 2.1 Rule 4 of the Rules is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-rule (1) of the following sub-rule:-

“(1) a practitioner must accumulate at least 30 continuing education units, of which at least five must be on human rights, ethics and medical law, within every year.”
