## APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING LICENCE CONDITIONS: KANGALA COMMUNITY RADIO

- The amendment application seeks to enable the licensee to install a second transmitter in the Kwaggafontein area using 98.7 MHz with an ERP of 1000 Watts.

The licensee must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the satisfaction of the Authority that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person who made such written representations.
