APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND OBJECTIONS THERETO

SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 7B OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)

The undermentioned bodies and persons have applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of their heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

BADGE: On a background Argent, a goutté, the sinister curve fracted and curved inwards into the form of a stylised human heart, all in umbra, Gules.

2. APPLICANT: The Thomas Loxton Family League (H4/3/1/4078)

ARMS: Argent, a chevron checky between in chief two pheasants proper and in base a rod of aesculapius Sable, the head in the form of a torch, with flames and snake Gules; a chief Azure, in each flank a full and a half peak to base, the half peaks against the respective edges of the shield Argent.

MOTTO: SPECTEMUR AGENDO

3. APPLICANT: The South African Society of Occupational Medicine (SASOM) (H4/3/1/4085)

BADGE: An inverted demi-cogwheel, thereabove conjoined to a demispoked wheel all Sable, charged with a rod of aesculapius also Sable, entwined of a snake Tenne.

4. **APPLICANT:** Westonaria Local Municipality (H4/3/2/45)

FLAG: A rectangular green flag, proportion 2:3, charged in base with a yellow pile inverted embowed, thereupon another of black, charged with a white plough; the peak ensigned of a yellow sun, voided white, charged with a black mineshaft.

5. APPLICANT: Delmas Municipal Council (H4/3/2/157)

ARMS: Per chevron coupled Vert and Argent, in base dexter an open book Or, bound Sable, and sinister a maize cob proper, there below a cosmos flower also proper; a chief Or, over the partition line a chain per fess Sable and Argent, on the chief a barrulet enhanced nowy fitchy inverted, the point couped Azure, charged with a mineshaft wheel, thereupon a cogwheel all Argent, the axle in the form of a mascle, voided Sable. The shield is ensigned of a mural crown Or, there upon a bar Argent, charged with a bar wavy Azure. The shield is flanked on either side by a leaf Vert.

MOTTO: TOGETHER FOR GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT

6. APPLICANT: Delmas Municipal Council (H4/3/2/157)

FLAG: A rectangular flag proportion 2:3 per chevron coupled green and white, in base dexter an open yellow book, bound black, and sinister a maize cob proper, there below a cosmos flower also proper; a yellow chief, over the partition line a chain per fess black and white, on the chief a blue barrulet enhanced nowy fitchy inverted, the point couped, charged with a mineshaft wheel, thereupon a cogwheel all of white, the axle in the form of a mascle, voided of black.

7. APPLICANT: Kungwini Local Municipality (H4/3/2/816)

ARMS: Azure, issuant from a bridge Or, masoned Sable, with two arches Argent, a demi-sun Or, and in base three barrulets wavy Argent; on a chief Or, between two ears of wheat Vert, a pile inverted Argent, fimbriated Sable, there-upon an ox head proper. The shield is ensigned of a coronet Or, heightened of four cosmos flowers and alternated with as many slices of brown bread, all proper, issuant from the coronet a demi-cogwheel

Gules, ensigned with a quatrefoil Argent. The shield is flanked on either side by a maize-cob and leaves proper.

MOTTO: GROWING WITH CHANGE

8. APPLICANT: Metsimaholo Local Municipality (H4/3/2/817)

ARMS: Per fess wavy Or and Vert, and in chief per chevron inverted embowed throughout Argent, a chevron inverted embowed throughout Azure, charged with a chevron inverted embowed Argent, between dexter a cogwheel and sinister a laboratory boiling flask all Sable, in base two chevronels coupled charged with a third all of the first, a base wavy Argent and Azure. The Shield is ensigned of a Basotho Hat and flanked on either side of a sprig of seeded grass proper.

MOTTO: MMOHO RE AHA BOKAMOSO

9. APPLICANT: Greater Marble Hall Municipality (H4/3/2/825)

ARMS: Per chevron coupled the peaks embattled Or and Vert, in chief a plough proper, on a base wavy Argent and Azure a railway line in perspective Sable and Or. The shield is ensigned of a coronet or, charged with a bar of marble proper, heightened of four oranges and alternated with as many balls of cotton proper. The shield is flanked on either side by a leafed bunch of grapes, a spinach leaf and an ear of wheat.

MOTTO: REHLABOLLA SETCHABA

10. APPLICANT: Wessel Johannes Kriek (H4/3/4/821)

ARMS: Argent between two bunches of grapes proper an escutcheon Sable, charged with two rifles in saltire of the first, and in base a thorn tree issuant proper; on a chief embattled Vert a sun Or, between two mullets Argent.

CREST: Issuant from a crest coronet Or, embellished with rubies and emeralds, heightened with four crosses paty and as many Latin crosses Or, a stone mount Sable, statant thereupon a black eagle with wings displayed proper.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Vert and Argent.

MOTTO: WEISHEIT UND HELDENMUT

11. APPLICANT: Andres Andalis Bolivar (H4/3/4/852)

ARMS: Gules, a lion rampant Or, within a bordure Purpure, and a tressure flory Argent.

CREST: Issuant from a crest coronet Or, heightened with six pearls Argent, alternated with as many ostrich feathers Or, a cross paty, the lower limb extended Argent.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Purpure and Argent.

MOTTO: AVI NUMERANTUR AVORUM

12. APPLICANT: Andres Andalis Bolivar (H4/3/4/852)

HERALDIC BANNER: A Rectangular banner, proportion 2:3, Gules, a lion rampant Or, within a bordure Purpure, and a treassure flory Argent.

13. APPLICANT: Andrea Carlo Maria Chiusoli Certani (H4/3/4/860)

ARMS: Azure, on a bend Or, three Turkey Oak trees (*Quercus cerris*) eradicated proper; on a chief Bleu Celeste, between three fleurs-de-lis Or, a label of four points Gules.

CREST: Issuant from a ducal coronet proper a Lynx rampant Tenne, armed Azure, holding in its dexter forepaw a Turkey Oak tree (*Quercus cerris*) eradicated and fructed in bend sinister proper, and in the sinister paw a pomegranate (*Punica granatum*) proper.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Or.

MOTTO:	Above the Crest:	CERRETO!
	Below the shield:	LABOR EST VITA

14. APPLICANT: Giacomo Cerasomma (H4/3/4/870)

ARMS: Azure, a bar Or, between in chief a comet of the second and in base a rose Gules, barbed Vert, seeded Or, fimbriated Argent.

CREST: In front of an ostrich plume in bend sinister Gules, ribbed Or, a comet in bend Or.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Or.

MOTTO: SUMMA EST IMAGO MEA

15. APPLICANT: Bennett Arthur September (H4/3/4/879)

ARMS: Argent, issuant from either side of a church Gules, door, windows and bell Or, a laurel wreath Vert, the church ensigned over the bell tower with a slave bell, pillars and arch Brunâtre and bell Or; on a chief nowy Gules, a chain fesswise Or. The shield is ensigned of waves of the sea, there upon a ship in full sail proper, with pennants flotant Gules, charged upon each main sail three interlinked annulets, placed one and two Sable.

MOTTO: Above the Crest: OUR TRUST IN GOD Below the shield: YESTERDAY, TODAY AND TOMORROW

16. APPLICANT: Petru Morar (H4/3/4/884)

ARMS: Quarterly, Argent and Or, over the division line, a wooden cross throughout proper, between in chief dexter a black bear, and sinister a severed closed dexter hand, and in base dexter a representation of the Tower of Trajan and sinister a lion rampant all proper, charged on the cross, at honour point an eagle with wings displayed, in its beak a cross in pale, all Or, on the upper limb an eight pointed faceted mullet Argent, and on the dexter and sinister limbs each representations of the obverse and reverse sides of an ancient golden Roman Koson coin proper.

CREST: Issuant from a crest coronet Or, heightened of four eight pointed faceted mullets Argent, alternated with as many bezants, a mound Vert, there upon within two protea flower wreaths issuant, a Harvard aeroplane, ensigned of a sword and rifle all proper, charged at the cross point with an eight pointed faceted mullet Argent.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Azure and Or.

MOTTO: NIHIL SINE DEO

17. APPLICANT: Giovanni Zoia (H4/3/4/885)

ARMS: Argent, on a base Vert a castle with two towers Gules, with windows and portal of the first, a base wavy Argent and Azure; on a chief Or, filleted Sable a crowned eagle with wings displayed Sable.
