SCHEDULE

Definitions

 In these regulations, "the Regulations " means the Regulations Relating to Maximum Levels of Metals in Foodstuffs, published under Government Notice No. R.500 of 30 April 2004.

Amendment of the Annexure to the Regulations

2. The Annexure to the Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following texts, opposite the expression "cadmium" (Cd)", as indicated underneath:
