**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION OF A TRADE
UNION**

I, Johannes Theodorus Crouse, Registrar of Labour Relations, hereby, in terms of section 106(2B) give notice of my intention to cancel the registration of the **Impartial Workers Union of South Africa** for the following reasons:

- The union ceased to function in terms of its constitution
- The union did not comply with the provisions of section 98, 99 and 100 of the Act [Section 106(2A)(b)]

All interested parties are hereby invited to make written representations as to why the registration should not be cancelled. **Only representations pertaining to this Notice will be considered. All correspondence should refer to case number 161/2008.**
