NOTIFICATION BY **PRESIDENT** IN RESPECT OF **ENTITIES** IDENTIFIED THE UNITED **NATIONS** SECURITY COUNCIL: SECTION 25 OF THE **PROTECTION** OF CONSTITUTIONAL DEMOCRACY AGAINST TERRORIST AND RELATED ACTIVITIES ACT, 2004

- I, Thabo Mvuyelwa Mbeki, President of the Republic of South Africa, hereby, in terms of section 25 of the Protection of Constitutional Democracy against Terrorist and Related Activities Act, 2004 (Act No. 33 of 2004), give notice that the Security Council of the United Nations, under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, has amended the information reflected in the Annexure in respect of an entity which have been identified as being -
  - an entity who commits, or attempts to commit, any terrorist and related activity or participates in or facilitates the commission of any terrorist and related activity; or
  - (b) an entity against whom Member States of the United Nations must take the actions specified in the Resolutions of the said Security Council, in order to combat or prevent terrorist and related activities.
