## APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND OBJECTIONS THERETO

SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 7B OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)

The undermentioned bodies and persons have applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of their heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

1. APPLICANT: The South African Air Force Association (H4/3/1/312)

BADGE: An eagle recursant with wings displayed Or, charged on the breast with an escutcheon Azure; issuant outwards from beneath its tail and claws a ribbon of the first charged on the dexter side with the letters SAAFA and on the sinister side SALV, Sable.

2. APPLICANT: The South African Air Force Association (H4/3/1/312)

FLAG: A rectangular Air Force Blue flag, proportion 2:3, charged in the centre with an eagle recursant with wings displayed Or, charged on the breast with an escutcheon Azure; issuant outwards from beneath its tail and claws a ribbon of the first charged on the dexter side with the letters SAAFA and on the sinister side SALV, Sable.

 APPLICANT: The South African Council for Social Service Professions (H4/3/1/4088)

ARMS: Per chevron embowed Or, and Brunâtre and in chief per chevron grady inverted Vert, in chief a demi-sun Or, in the flanks dexter a torch Or, enflamed Gules, sinister a triquetra Vert and in base fretty Or. The shield is ensigned of an inkpot Sable. Behind the shield a protea flower Gules, seeded Argent, slipped Vert and a quill pen Argent, the nib and shaft Sable in saltire. The shield is flanked by two laurel wreaths their slips terminating in saltire below the shieldbase Vert.

MOTTO: BOTHO PELE - HUMANITY FIRST

4. APPLICANT: Evangelistic Congregational Church (H4/3/1/4094)

BADGE: An oval in fess Azure, charged in the centre with two doves volant respectant Argent, together holding an olive branch Vert, the whole within a bordure per bordure Gules and Or.

MOTTO: UNITY IN CHRIST

5. APPLICANT: The Georg Albrecht Scheuer Family Assosciation (H4/3/1/4099)

ARMS: Azure, the five central pipes of a church organ Argent, flanked on either side of leafed woodcarvings Brunâtre; a chief Argent.

6. APPLICANT: Thembisile Hani Local Municipality (H4/3/2/828)

ARMS: Vert, on a chevron embowed Or, a lion passant proper, in chief dexter a cogwheel Or, sinister an indigenous Ndebele cross painting of Argent, Sable, Or and Vert; at honour point a lion's footprint Brunâtre; in base a mound Vert. The shield is ensigned upon a wreath Or and Vert, of a mural crown Sable, charge with a bar per fess Sable and Or. The shield is flanked on either side with two bulrushes, slipped and leafed, issuant from the motto ribbon, proper.

MOTTO: ITUHUKO ENZINZILEKO

7. APPLICANT: The South African Police Service: Counter Assault Team (H4/3/3/10/20)

BADGE: Within a pair of wings Or, each charged with a laurel wreath Vert, an indigenous Nguni shield pied at random Argent (white) and Brunâtre, the head of the spine entwined of a skin pied at random of Sable and Argent (white); behind the shield a spear and knobkierie in saltire proper.
