Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No. 130 of 1993) as amended.

Notice to all employees who were injured on duty before 1 July 2008.

All employees who were injured on duty and the claim was accepted but payment of compensation in respect of periodical payment (salary) was refused on the ground that they were not receiving "active medical treatment" are hereby invited to contact the nearest Provincial Office/Labour Office of the Department of Labour or the Compensation Fund to have their claims reviewed. The following information should be readily available:

- 1. Claim number.
- ID of certified copy thereof.
- 3. Employer's Name.
- 4. Date of the accident.
- 5. A letter from the Compensation Commissioner which clearly states that the periodical treatment is refused on the basis that the employee did not receive active medical treatment.
