CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

QUANTITY SURVEYING PROFESSION ACT 2000 (ACT NO 49 OF 2000)

Section 3.(1)(d):

Through an open process of public participation: Invitation to nominate one or more persons who are members of the public, for consideration and possible appointment by the Minister of Public Works as members of the South African Council for the Quantity Surveying Profession

Section 4.(2):

When any nomination becomes necessary in terms of Section 3(1)(d) the Council must invite the public via notice in the Government Gazette and any newspaper the Council considers necessary, but at least in a leading newspaper in each province, to nominate persons, in the prescribed manner, within a period of at least 60 days from the date of the notice

The following should be noted:

- Two vacancies need to be filled.
- Nominations are to be submitted on the nomination form attached to this Notice, with completed acceptance forms.
- Successful Nominees will be appointed in their own right and not as representatives of any particular organisation/s.
- All Nominees must be South African citizens and ordinarily resident in the Republic.
- Nominations and acceptances must be submitted to the Registrar of the Council within 60 days of the date of this Notice
- Late nominations will not be considered.

EXPLANATORY NOTE: THE RULES FOR THE PROPERTY VALUERS PROFESSION, 2008

1. As can be expected, the (current) Rules for the Property Valuers Profession, 2003, and its six amendments (containing substantial additions, changes, deletions, insertions, etc), have become somewhat unclear and indefinite and, therefore, rather demanding to comprehend.
2. The Council has, therefore, decided to consolidate the said Rules and its amendments, but without in any way amending any matters of principle contained in the provisions concerned.
3. The "new" Rules does not have to be first published in terms of subsection (2) of section 37 of the Property Valuers Profession Act, 2000, but is hereby published in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section 37.
