DECLARATION OF MEDICINE AS UNDESIRABLE (SECTION 23 OF ACT 101 OF 1965)

The Medicines Control Council is, in terms of Section 23 of the Medicines and Related Substances Act 101 of 1965, of the opinion that it is not in the public interest that the following medicines, which are not registered with the Medicines Control Council, be made available to the public, and has declared the medicines undesirable:

- (a) Mojo Capsules;
- (b) Dr Lee Shaggy Sex Cocktail Capsules;
- (c) Santi Capsules;
- (d) Canova;
- (e) Time Diet Mixture;
- (f) Party-pills/Funk pills; and
- (g) Malaria ant parasitic precaution (MAPP).

In terms of Section 23(3) no person shall sell any medicines that have been declared undesirable.
