NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND THE PRESCRIBED MONETARY THRESHOLD IN RESPECT OF THE PURCHASER'S RIGHT TO REVOKE AN OFFER OR TERMINATE A DEED OF ALIENATION

In terms of section 29A(5)(a) of the Alienation of Land Act, the Minister of Trade and Industry is empowered to prescribe the monetary threshold in respect of the purchaser's right to revoke an offer or terminate a deed of alienation.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Trade and Industry is considering, for the purpose of section 29A(5)(a) of the Alienation of Land Act, to increase the prescribed monetary threshold from R250 000, 00 to R500 000,00.
