HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA (Health Professions Act No.56 of 1974)

RULES RELATING TO FEES PAYABLE TO COUNCIL

The Health Professions Council of South Africa intends, in terms of section 61A (1)(e) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), and after consultation with the Professional Boards, to make the rules in the Schedule.

Interested persons are invited to submit any substantiated comments or representation in writing on the proposed rules to the Registrar, Health Professions Council of South Africa, P O Box 205, Pretoria, 0001 (for the attention of the General Manger: Professional Boards), within three (3) months from date of publication of this Notice.

SCHEDULE

 - (i) within a period of six months after the suspension date, shall be equivalent to two (2) times the applicable annual fee for the current year, plus the outstanding fee or fees;
 - (ii) after a period of six months after the suspension date, but within 12 months from date of suspension, shall be equivalent to four (4) times the applicable annual fee for the current year, plus the outstanding fee or fees; and
 - (iii) after a period of more than 12 months had expired from the suspension date, shall be equivalent to five (5) times the applicable annual fee for the current year plus the outstanding fee or fees.
