## FOODSTUFFS, COSMETICS AND DISINFECTANTS ACT, 1972 (ACT 54 OF 1972) REGULATION: PRESERVATIVES AND ANTIOXIDANTS: AMENDMENT

The Minister of Health has, in terms of section 15(1) of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act 54 of 1972), made the regulations in the Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

#### Definitions

R. 2355 of 5 November 1982, R. 225 of 7 February 1986, R. 1884 of 4 September 1987, R. 2379 of 12 October 1990, R. 2139 of 30 August 1991, R. 70 of 15 January 1993, R. 1142 of 4 August 1995, R. 1745 of 1 November 1996 and R. 1295 of 16 October 1998.
