The Councils for the Built Environment Professions

Call for Nominations for Members of the Public to be appointed as Members to the Councils for the Built Environment Professions.

In terms of the Architectural Profession Act , 2000 (Act 44 of 2000), and the Engineering Professions Act, 2000 (Act 46 of 2000), nominations are invited from members of the general public to the following Councils:

- South African Council for the Architectural Profession: 2 vacancies.
- Engineering Council of South Africa: 10 vacancies.

Background

In December 2000, the President assented to legislation providing for the establishment of Councils for the professions of architecture and engineering. These councils were established in August 2001 and replaced the previous statutory Councils and boards for these professions. The various councils register professionals and candidates within their respective professions, uphold professional conduct, identify functions of each profession, recommend professional fees and promote regional and international recognition of the professions.

Each of the Councils will meet at least twice a year and will be supported by administrative staff. The period of office for the members is four years.

Each nomination must be in writing and must contain the following information in the detail required by the individual Councils. (*Please refer to them directly for further information*.)

- 1. The Council for which the nomination is made;
- 2. The name and address of the nominating person or organization;
- 3. The name, address and identity number of the nominee.
- 4. A declaration, signed by the nominee that he or she is prepared to serve on the relevant council or/ and any of its Committees and is not disqualified from serving on the relevant Council**
- 5. Motivation for the appointment of the nominee to the relevant Council (not exceeding one page).
- 6. A short Curriculum Vitae of the nominee (not exceeding two pages)

Nominations should reach the respective Councils at the addresses below not later than **6 May 2009**. No late submissions will be accepted. For further information please contact the respective Council at the addresses below.
