SCHEDULE

DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: GREYTON

That portion of land situated within the following boundaries:

Start at the north-western beacon of Kanon Berg 33 (Trigonometric beacon 12 on the Riviersonderend Mountains); thence generally south-east with the general northern boundaries of said Kanon Berg 33, Galge Berg 34, Zilvermyn 36, farm 144, The Oaks 145, farm 144, Bye Nest Krantz 153 and Zonder End Forest Reserve 168 to a point where the north-eastern boundary of *quaternary catchments area H60H intersects the northern boundary of said Zonder End Forest Reserve 168; thence generally south with the eastern boundary of said catchment area H60H to a point where the 200 metre contour intersects said boundary; thence generally west with said contour to a point where it intersects the southern boundary of catchment area H60F; thence first west and then generally north with the southern and western boundaries of said catchment area H60F to where it joins the north-western beacon of Kanon Berg 33, the point of beginning mentioned above.
