#### FOODSTUFFS, COSMETICS AND DISINFECTANTS ACT, 1972 (ACT NO. 54 OF 1972) REGULATIONS RELATING TO FOODS FOR INFANTS, YOUNG CHILDREN AND CHILDREN: DRAFT AMENDMENT

The Minister of Health intends, in terms of section 15 (1) of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972), to make the regulations in the Schedule.

Interested persons are invited to submit any substantiated comments or representations on the proposed draft amendment to the regulations, to the Director – General of Health, Private Bag X828, Pretoria, 0001 (for the attention of the Director: Food Control), within three months of the date of publication of this notice.

#### SCHEDULE

##### 1. Definitions

In these regulations, "**the Regulations**" means the regulations published under Government Notice No. R. 1130 of 8 June 1984, as amended by Government Notice No. R. 2542 of 15 November 1985.

##### 2. Amendment regulation 2 of the Regulations

Regulation 2 of the regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for item (iv) of paragraph (c)(aa) of the following item:

- "(iv) more than 0,02 mg/kg of lead in ready-to-use form of such formula or more than 0,5 mg/kg of lead in the dehydrated concentrated form of such formula;"
