## NOMINATIONS FOR REPRESENTATIVES TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH LABORATORY SERVICE (NHLS)

Nominations are invited for all interested persons in terms of Section 8(2) of the National Health Laboratory Service Act, 2000 (Act No 37 of 2000), for two persons who meet the requirement of Section 7(d) of the Act and fit to be so appointed, stating the grounds upon which such opinion is based. Section 7(d) provides for the following members –

Three members who have special knowledge in -

- (i) economics, financial matter or accounting;
- (ii) legal matters;
- (iii) health research: or
- (iv) epidemiology

Attention is drawn to the requirement that the members of the Board, other than those who serve ex officio, may hold office for a period of at least three years, as the Minister may determine at the time of appointment. A member of the Board, excluding a member who is in the full-time employment of the State or the Service, must be appointed on such conditions, as the Minister may, with concurrence of the Minister of Finance, determine.

Nominations are also referred to Section 10 of the Act for the conditions and exclusions relating to appointment to the Board.
